



# KeySafe

#### What is it?

It is a secure way to provide multiple visitors with access to a property without a large volume of keys being in circulation, whilst helping to avoid losing door keys. It is ideal for people living independently. It enables trusted carers, family and neighbours to access the house when required.

## How does it work?

The KeySafe is a small, discreet safe for keys. A code must be entered in order to gain access to the safe. It is extremely robust, being made of a heavy gauge, stainless steel and a zinc alloy shell with a double wall construction. A clutch mechanism prevents the handle from being forced open. A stainless steel plate around the buttons adds additional security. It is secure against physical attack when mounted on a brick wall with the masonry screws included.

### **Features**

- An easy push button keypad
- Over 4000 possible code combinations
- Tough, weatherproof cover made of rubber, which protects against the weather and helps to disguise the safe
- Police accreditation for its security installation requires some level of DIY skills

If the user purchases a **package**, and is therefore subscribed to a 24/7 monitoring service, the operator can share the code with the emergency services to ensure that they can gain immediate entry to the property if required.
